3 — WHY, AND WHAT NEXT

The reason for each mark in plain terms, then the single most useful next step: *for +1 point, practise the plural adjective endings and put the finite verb in second place.*

Every learner gets all three levels — the mark per criterion, the correction in the text, and a concrete tip that raises the grade — instantly and identically. No teacher can hold this depth across 25–30 papers: focus and fairness fade with each one, and most of all late in the evening after teaching. The AI grades the 28th piece as carefully as the first.

KEY FEATURES

A1–C1 in structured chapters, calibrated to Goethe/telc.

First-language help — English, Ukrainian, Russian, Polish, Turkish, Arabic.

Four-criteria grading with model answer, half-points, mild/strict.

Speaking, recorded live — record on a phone or speak directly; the AI grades pronunciation and stress.

HOW A CHAPTER IS BUILT — SIX SKILLS, ONE THREAD

Each chapter opens with an overview ("What you'll learn / how to use it") and runs through every skill, with real dialogues from everyday to professional life. **Conversations** are graded from simple to demanding and voiced, so learners hear the right pronunciation and stress. **Reading & listening** use authentic texts with comprehension questions. **Speaking & writing** come with a model solution and are graded on four criteria. **Vocabulary and grammar** each come as a searchable library, flashcards and a test — vocabulary banded by level (A2–C1) and by real-life situation (authorities, tenancy, job applications, health, banking, social insurance), with synonyms, antonyms and example sentences.

THE READER — MAKE ANY TEXT READABLE

Paste a URL or drop in text, a PDF, an image or a Word file — the AI marks the hard words at the learner's level and names the grammar patterns; new words move into the learner's own vocabulary with one click. A real newspaper article, an official letter or a tenancy contract becomes readable — not just the prepared course material. Privacy: nothing is stored; content is processed for the session only. Translation on demand, in six first languages.

PRACTISE, TEST, REPEAT — WITH AN ADAPTIVE TEST

Reading comprehension and exercises are fully auto-checked, with graded hints, instant resolution and an evaluation score. In addition, on request the AI generates new, targeted questions exactly where the learner is still weak. Fixed exercises per section, plus a mixed drill across the whole chapter; a fully objective evaluation with no marking-pile to clear.

The complete cycle: **01 Teach** → **02 Practise** → **03 Test** → **04 Evaluate** → **05 Repeat, aimed at weaknesses**

INTRODUCE IT WITHOUT RISK — THE PROPOSAL

In the first year a teacher can spot-check the AI's grades — a control that it works reliably; they confirm rather than mark. Once it proves out, the AI takes grading fully. Offering more, not less: once lessons are recorded and the AI takes grading and questions, one site can offer many more courses — further languages, levels, literacy, vocational content — without finding and funding a separate specialist for each. **Proposal:** a limited pilot — one course, one semester, a present companion for supervision and support. The platform is built and in use — no development cost.
